'+' Signifies a small \$1-\$8 car pooling contribution to be paid directly to the driver depending on travel distance.

There is a \$3 switching fee to transfer money from one workshop to another, \$5 handling fee for refunds.

Discounts: Children 0-6 are free, 7-17 pay their age for 'standard' workshops. All children must be accompanied by an adult.

There are \$3 discounts each for adult family members attending together, Native Americans, Scout Leaders, full time college students, and the involuntarily unemployed. No more than \$3 off/adult/workshop. Student groups are not eligible for these discounts.
